To decide whether to use *c* or *k*, listen for the vowel sound after /k/. Spelling with *c* and *k* depends on the vowel that follows. *K* takes *i* and *e*. *C* takes *a*, *o*, and *u*.

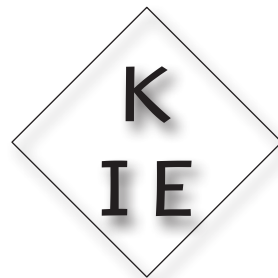
