We were thrilled when the bus stopped at the ranch.
The man docked his rusted ship.

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grabbed	scrubbed	mended
pumped	skinned	hatched
golfed	flapped	trusted
rented	locked	added

Fran scrubbed the dishes and boxed them up.
The rented truck is all locked up.

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rotted	camped	hunted
ended	squinted	jammed
stuffed	asked	chatted
plugged	fixed	grilled

They camped by the rotted log.
Ling and I chatted as we grilled fish.

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tugged	tipped	twisted
planted	sanded	hummed
hugged	dressed	stopped
boxed	whacked	mended

We sanded and mended the deck.
The path stopped at the end of the twisted log.

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hugged	ended	rusted
stopped	spotted	fanned
asked	trapped	slipped
prodded	thanked	called

I thanked my mom for the gift.
When we stopped running, we asked for a drink.

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grinned	tapped	planted
asked	ripped	slipped
boxed	picked	mended
rented	jogged	packed

We jogged on the path by the pond.
The ripped pants have been mended.

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ended	squinted	jammed
camped	flapped	trusted
buzzed	dressed	filmed
added	fixed	plugged

Mom fixed the plugged tub.
The bug buzzed and flapped its wings.

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landed	jumped	crammed
pumped	twisted	buzzed
sanded	hugged	planted
jammed	boxed	backed

We crammed all of the stuff into the big trunk.
I jumped off of the dock and landed in the water.

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rocked	flopped	hunted
switched	flipped	trusted
